Required Immunization Timeline*

Year	Immunizations
Incoming 1 st Year Student All documentation must be uploaded into E*Value by Friday, August 16, 2013	1. Bacterial Meningitis - Texas State law (SB 1107) mandates that <u>all entering students under the age of</u> <u>30</u> provide a certificate signed by a health care provider or an official immunization record verifying that a student has been vaccinated against bacterial meningitis, or has received a booster during the five years prior to registration. Students may also submit proof of approved conscience exemption from the Texas Department of State Health Services (http://www.uh.edu/immunization). Visit bacterial meningitis for current deadlines.
	2. Hepatitis B ⁺ – The Hepatitis B series consists of three doses, with the second given one month after the first dose and the third dose given six months after the first dose. A completed series of 3 doses of vaccine administered prior to January 15, 2014.
	 3. MMR Measles⁺ – Two doses of measles vaccine administered since January 1, 1968, and on or after the student's first birthday and at least 28 days apart. Mumps⁺ – One dose of mumps vaccine administered on or after the student's first birthday. Rubella⁺ – One dose of rubella vaccine administered on or after the student's first birthday.
	 TB Skin Test[^] – Test to be administered between June 7th – August 14th, 2013. TB Skin Test documentation must include the date TB test was placed, date TB test was read and the results of TB test.
	5. TDap (Tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis vaccine) – TDap is required for all incoming students.
	6. Varicella Titer – Varicella titer is required for all incoming students, regardless of immunity or serologic evidence of infections.
1 st Year Student	1. Influenza Vaccine – TBA during flu season.
	 2. TB Skin Test[^] – Test to be administered between May 1st - May 10th TB Skin Test documentation must include the date TB test was placed, date TB test was read and the results of TB test.
2 nd Year Student	1. Influenza Vaccine – TBA during flu season.
	 2. TB Skin Test[^] – Test to be administered between May 1st - May 10th TB Skin Test documentation must include the date TB test was placed, date TB test was read and the results of TB test.
3 rd Year Student	1. Influenza Vaccine – TBA during flu season.
	 2. TB Skin Test[^] – Test to be administered between March 30th – April 8th TB Skin Test documentation must include the date TB test was placed, date TB test was read and the results of TB test.
4 th Year Student	1. Influenza Vaccine – TBA during flu season.

*Some institutions may have more stringent requirements so further vaccination may be required prior to experiential rotations.

+Serologic confirmation of immunity or serologic evidence of infection is acceptable in lieu of vaccination.

 S populations who have traveled internationally and/or those of you who are aware that you may get a false positive result which would require a chest x-ray, may wish to obtain the QuantiFERON – TB Gold Test.
